CALL FOR PAPER

Authors are asked to submit in English an abstract of the planned paper, which should describe the topic and set out the main aspects and structure of the study (300–500 words). After a preliminary review and the acceptance of the abstract, the respective authors will be requested to submit the English original and unpublished papers meeting high academic research standards. Submitted papers will be subject to a double-blind peer review.

The deadline for presenting abstract to this call for papers is December 15, 2016.

Notification of abstract acceptance will be January 31, 2017.

Full paper must be sent before May 31, 2017. Authors will be notified of the final acceptance of the contribution, after the double-blind peer review.

The book will be published 3-9 months after the Publisher’s receipt and acceptance of the final edited version of the book. Authors must sign a Copyright Transfer Form.

The book will focus on the 'core' aspects of peacekeeping. The Call for Papers invites submissions that will increase understanding of the most critical peacekeeping issues in present times. The book is open to submissions addressing topics from technical, economic, legal, policy, strategy and military perspectives.
